The **One-Start-Rule** will be applied for the whole competition.

For all immersion disciplines (IM) only cylinders with a valid DIN/EN-certificate may be used. The organizer offers compressor service. (DIN; pressure up to 200 Bar) Only cylinders with valid DIN/EN certificate will be filled. Please provide your own adapters.

The contests will be carried out in heats with time classification, independently of the age of the competitors and as direct finals.

The organizer keeps the right for modification of the program because of organizational reasons. The organizer keeps the right to combine contests to one heat, independently of the gender of the competitors, if necessary.



Documents:

Each athlete must have a medical certificate not older than a year at the date of the competition.

Each athlete must have a valid license of the national diving confederation which is member of the CMAS.

The documents must be shown at the registration before the competition starts.

Ranking and results:

International Ranking: the competitors of each contest will be rated in the open category (A) The first 3 competitors will be honoured with medals.

Austrian Championships: The Austrian competitors of each contest will be rated in the open category (A). The first 3 competitors will be honoured with medals.

Austrian Junior Championships: The Austrian competitors of each contest will be rated in their categories (B, C, D or E) according to their year of birth. The first 3 competitors will be honoured with medals.

Registrations:

The registration should be carried out on the attached entry forms and sent electronically to the mentioned e-Mail address.

Only registrations by e-Mail will be accepted.

Please fill in the current personal best time for each individual start as well as for each relay team. Otherwise the registered time will be set on „no time“ (99:99:99).

Protest: Protests must be submitted in writing to the Chief Judge within 30 minutes after release of the result. The protest fee is € 20,-.

A jury will be determined at the first team leader meeting.

Liability: The organizer declines any liability. All competitors take part on their own risk.
